ii)	Technician Apprentices (Mechanical - one post) (Automobile - one post)	a) A diploma in mechanical engineering/automobile engineering or technology granted by a State Council or Board of Technical Education established by a State Government. b) A diploma in engineering or technology granted by a University. c) A diploma in engineering or technology granted by an institute recognised by the State Government or Central Government as equivalent to (a) and (b) and (c) above. d) A sandwich course student who is undergoing training in order that he may hold a diploma mentioned in (a) ,(b) and (c) above.


And Subject to conditions provided in the Apprentices Rules ,1992 section 3(2).
