Call for Articles

The *Indian Journal of Transport Management* (IJTM) invites research articles and papers from academicians and practitioners in all fields of transportation and its management.

Guidance Notes for Authors

- 1. The IJTM is addressed to the field of road transport and its management. Articles prepared exclusively for the Journal must be academically sound, supported with relevant field work/research and presented in a simple and direct style. They must make an *original* contribution to the discipline.
- 2. Articles should, preferably, be between 6000-10000 words exclusive of charts, tables and other graphics. The manuscripts should generally contain Abstract, Introduction, Main Text, Conclusion and References. References and footnotes should be presented separately at the end of the manuscript and appropriately numbered, and include full details of the name(s) of the author(s), title of the article or book, name of the journal, details of the publishers, and the year and month of publication as appropriate.

The References should be presented in the following style:-

In case of book : (1) Sen Amariya, *Inequality Re-examined*, Clarendon Press, Oxford, 1992, pp. 44-45.

In case of article: (1) Gore M. L., *Tyres and Road Safety*, Indian Journal of Transport Management, Vol. 20, No. 2, February 1996, pp. 105-107.

- 3. Tables and charts should be serially numbered, sequentially following references to them in the text. The Source of data/information should be mentioned below the Table/Graphs etc.
- 4. All illustrations, tables and such other material should be with appropriate titles and headings, legend descriptions, and serial numbers. As a general rule, such material may be presented in A4 size, which would be appropriately reduced in the published text.
- 5. Since articles will be 'blind refereed', it is important that the main body of the article does not have the name of the author or any other detail of identification. The articles will be referred to the reviewers and will be published after they are cleared by the reviewers for publication in IJTM.
- 6. The article should be typed in 1.5 spacing preferably in A4 size stationery (Font: 12 pt Bookman Old Style) (Language: English (India). The soft copy of the article is to be submitted in MS Word format. If any other software is used, details should be provided to assist safe retrieval.
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- 10. Authors will receive a free copy of the IJTM in which their articles are published and honorarium for the article published.

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
